Canadian Parents for French (CPF) – Tri-Cities Chapter Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam, Port Moody Scholarship/Bursary Award(s) 2014-2015



1. Objective:

Canadian Parents for French (CPF) Tri-Cities Chapter annually provides scholarships/bursaries (under the guidance and discretion of the CPF Chapter Executive annually). These awards have a value ranging from \$250 to \$500 each, dependent on the number of awards given out.

The awards intent is to provide recognition and financial assistance to deserving Tri-Cities Grade 12 French Immersion and Francophone School students as they pursue career training that requires a higher education and the use of both of Canada's official languages.

2. Required Eligibility Criteria:

<u>Awards recipients are chosen only from qualified applicants.</u> Canadian Parents for French (CPF) Tri- Cities Chapter considers the following required criteria. Preference will be given to French Immersion and Francophone graduates of a secondary school in the Tri-Cities.

- Must be a CPF member or dependent of a CPF member, **BEFORE** March 15 of the year of application.
- Application to include *filling in the attached form and a statement written in French and English by the student*, copy of transcript or report cards, and <u>2</u> reference letters.
- **DEADLINE:** Completed Application must be received by <u>May 15</u> in the year of application. To be mailed directly to the Canadian Parents for French, Chapter Representative address below.

3. Recommended Selection Criteria:

Factors considered but not required are:

- Strong academic standing including GPA and Provincial Exam marks (if available)
- Recommendations from teachers and other community mentors, leaders
- Demonstrated all-round citizenship and leadership abilities
- Past support of CPF and other French activities in the community
- Interest or goals that include the teaching of French
- Career Goals which demonstrate that he/she intends to use both of Canada's Official Languages
- Demonstrated financial need only for bursary (if funds are available)

Receipt of another scholarship or bursary would NOT disqualify a student from receiving this award.

4. Presentation:

Award recipients will be notified before the end of the school year.

5. Claim Process:


The Scholarship/Bursary is paid in full by the CPF Tri-Cities Chapter upon receipt of the student's proof of registration *or conditional acceptance* by an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada or abroad. Award recipients may delay their studies for one academic year only (12 months) after which their award will no longer by redeemable.
