## Introductions and Housekeeping

1. Round table introductions.
2. Timekeeper designate: Kam Farahavar.
3. Minutes from previous meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve minutes of the PAC meeting held December 2, 2013. Moved by Kelly. Seconded by Alex. All in favour. Motion passed.

## School Report

1. Mr. Carabine's and Ms. Denton's report: there will be a guest speaker coming to the school assembly next week to talk about bullying. There was a presentation at the last assembly and Mr. Carabine and Ms. Denton provided an overview:

b. Description of bullying
c. Cyber bullying - changes to School Act have provided latitude on school's part to determine whether or not cyber bullying occurring outside of school should be dealt within the school system
d. Explanation of purposeful behaviour - why do bullies bully?
e. Tactics for discouraging bullying behaviour

## PAC Report

1. Traffic: ongoing issues with traffic at the school and congestion. Emil to send message on behalf of PAC to encourage respectful behaviour. ## Treasurer's Report

2. General account: Hot Lunch cost showing expenses for two lunches and revenue for one. Purdy's did well, will have Easter chocolate program. Parent Education expenses were for a guest speaker. A few teachers have used the Incentive Fund since last meeting. Office expense is for making online ordering form easier via the PAC website. Currently over budget for student laptops due to taxes, will be adjusted.

## New Business

1. Orders are ongoing for the Pink T-shirts for Bully Free School day in February.
2. After School Programs - Kung Ho Martial Arts Academy offer of services on-site. No space for another after school program at this time.
3. Multicultural focus: school has planned a multicultural event in May 2014. School in Burnaby or Coquitlam hosts a weekly parent event that focuses on various aspects of multiculturalism and something similar to this could be revisited in the future.
4. Mother's Day/ Father's Day/ Staff Appreciation Day - need to start planning for these events. Chair to send request for volunteers for this committee.
