## School Report

## New Business

1. Traffic proposal: Mr. Clarke reviewed the school's current traffic management philosophy, i.e. keep the traffic moving and be aware of children's safety with the RCMP. RCMP from the traffic division visited the school to review traffic/ congestion problems due to an increase in complaints. There were suggestions ranging from education to changing the parking lot protocol. There is a request to look at using a defined process for analyzing and making recommendations for traffic improvements. Mr. Clarke will engage the facilities administration to see if there are any traffic study results/ reports available as a starting point.
2. School Trustee Kerri Palmer-Isaak visited the PAC to introduce herself. She provided a brief background and explained the function of the School Trustee. Ms. Palmer-Isaak was elected in the November 2014 by-elections. Per the BCSTA website: trustees engage their communities in building and maintaining a school system that reflect local priorities.
